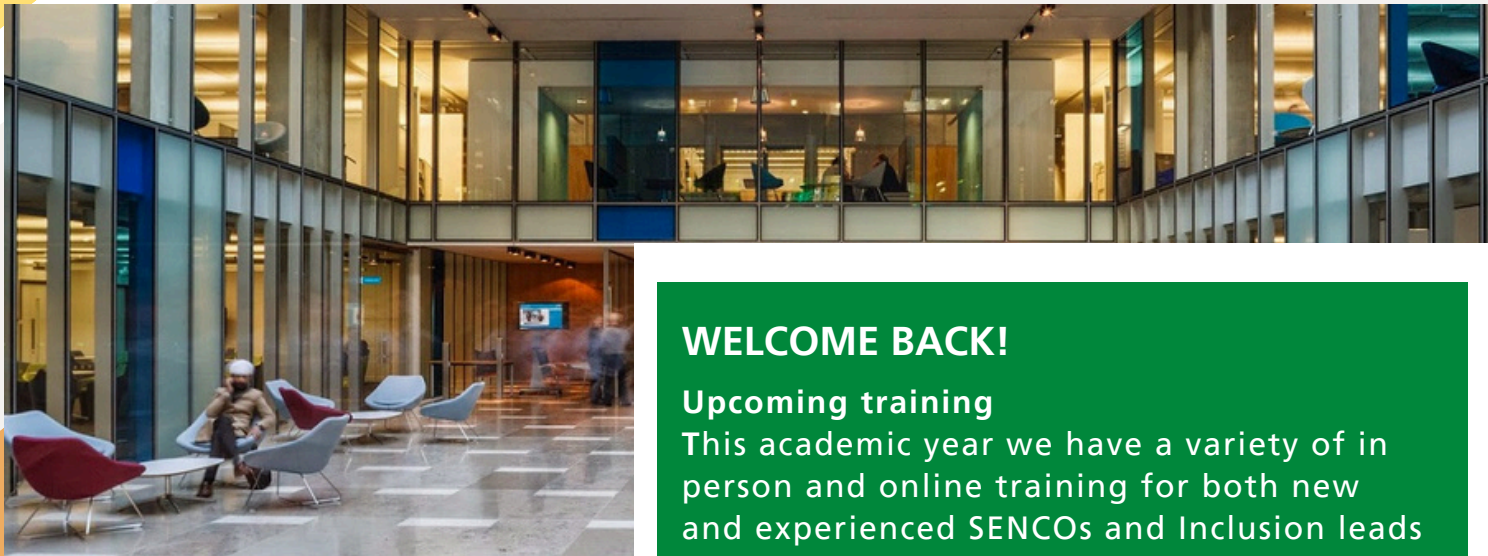

There's a new way to apply for early years SEND funding

The Early Years SEND Inclusion Funding has changed to Early Years Inclusion Funding, and can only be accessed through a new online portal. The named contact for school will receive an email invitation from EYIF@southwark.gov.uk by end of day on Friday 6th September. Please ensure your school has received this, and if not email EarlyYearsInclusion@southwark.gov.uk letting them know. The deadline for the first EYIF panel will be 3rd of October, so its important to check!
