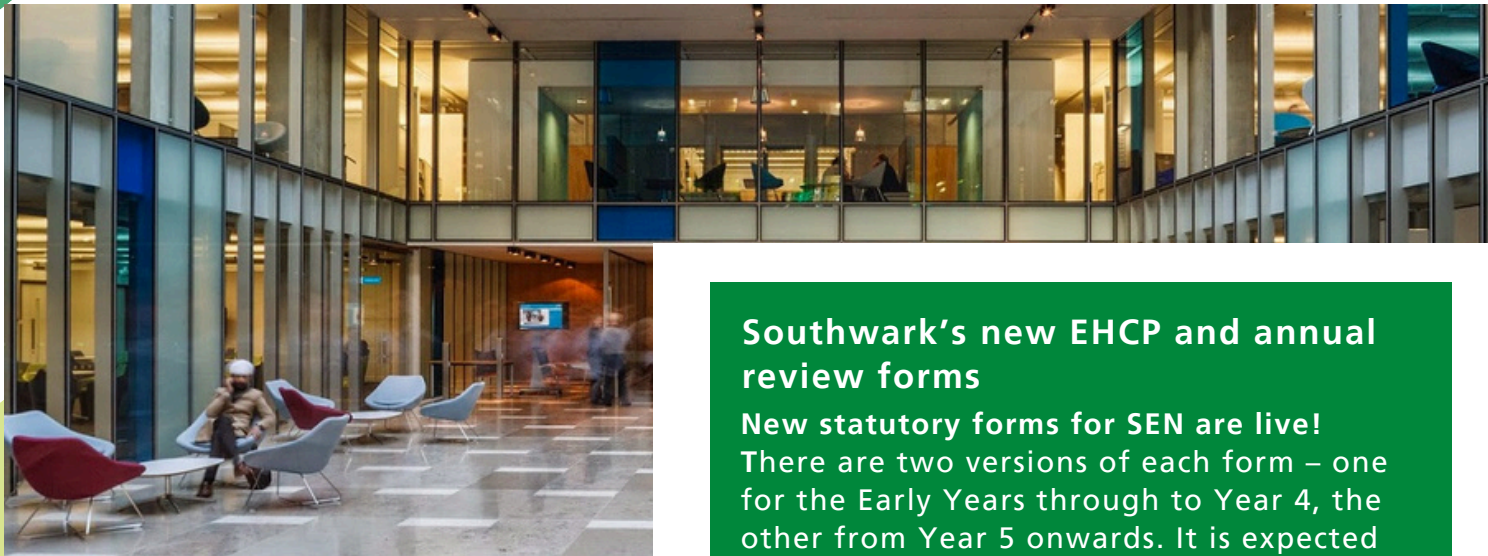

Southwark's new EHCP and annual review forms

New statutory forms for SEN are live!

There are two versions of each form – one for the Early Years through to Year 4, the other from Year 5 onwards. It is expected that settings will use the new forms as soon as they become available. However, as schools may still be completing some statutory processes on old forms, Southwark SEN will accept the old forms until **March 7th 2025**. After this date, any needs assessment requests or annual reviews submitted with the old forms will be returned with a request to utilise the new paperwork.

EARLY YEARS INCLUSION FUND

The deadline to apply for the early years SEND inclusion fund is the 27th Feb. This fund is for children from 9 months to 4 years old not attending a reception class and without an EHCP. The full eligibility criteria and application process can be found [HERE](#).

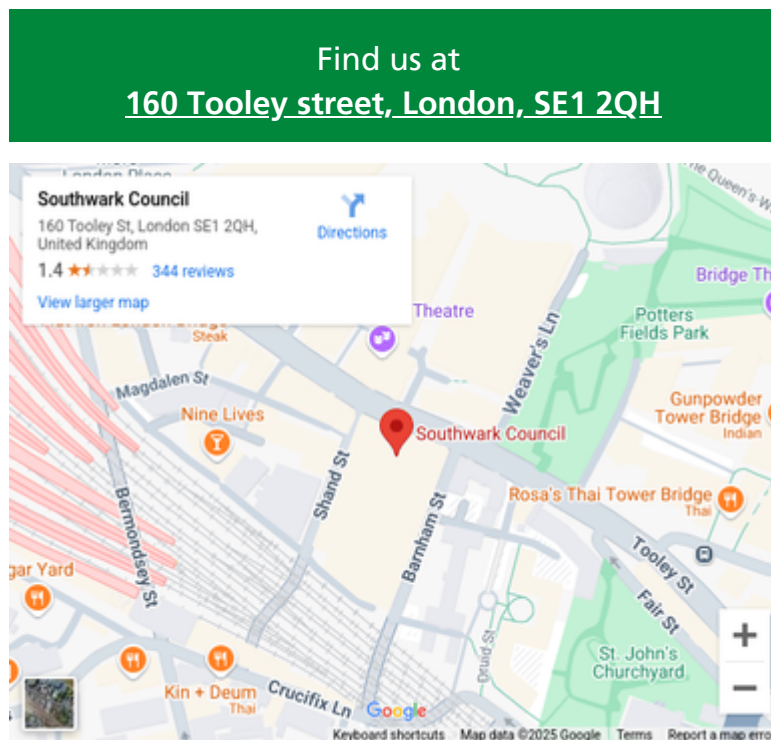
