Governors will also receive resources to support effective monitoring and compliance.

Finance in maintained schools

ESSENTIAL **Course description:** This session provides essential information for governors on their financial oversight responsibilities in schools. It covers key topics such as financial regulations, school funding and its annual cycle, budget setting and monitoring, and the roles of the governing body, school, and Local Authority. Please note Schools finance does not support or deal with academies. There is crossover between what is covered and academies., however there are some sections of the session that do not apply.
