Millwall Community Trust are proud to present these new programmes:

Millwall Premier League Primary Stars Programme



Premier League Primary Stars is a programme in which the Premier League has created with education specialists free, curriculum-linked Key Stage 1 and 2 resources, which can be used for lessons or to supplement existing in-class delivery of PE, PSHE, literacy and numeracy.

The programme aims to develop skills and aspiration both on and off the sports field with resources for girls and boys aged 5-11 years old.



Millwall Premier League Primary Partner Schools receive:

- 20 one hour football coaching sessions (2 sessions per week for 10 weeks), to include nutritional themed activity sessions
- Two intra-school football competitions and access to one inter school competition
- Six football coaching sessions for girls
- Free curriculum linked Key Stage 1 and 2 resources
- CPD opportunities through 1:1 mentoring with participating class teachers
- Bespoke 1 hour CPD workshop relating to the delivery of PE in Schools
- Tickets for pupils to attend selected Millwall FC and Millwall Lionesses first team and reserve matches free of charge



Zampa's School Experience

Have your children picked up by the Millwall bus from your school and taken to the Millwall Lions Centre. Start the day in our indoor synthetic turf pitch with educational activities followed by a coaching session and playing football matches. After lunch, children make their way over to the Press Lounge at The Den where pupils will have the chance to look out onto the pitch and write a report in the style of a football journalist. Pupils will then have a tour of the Den, with exclusive access to the first team dressing room, tunnel and our fantastic Family Stand.



Big Lottery Awards for All

Fully Funded Extra Curricular Sports Activity Programme

MCT will help you to fund and deliver an extra-curricular programme at your school:

- MCT and your school will agree upon proposed activities to be delivered
- MCT will write the bid on behalf of the school
- The school will submit the bid
- If the application is successful, MCT will deliver activity programmes for the school, which the school pays for through the funding received. Any equipment purchased for the programme, the school will keep.



The Junior Lions Schools Partnership

Millwall FC reaches out to schools in the local community. This is a joint initiative between local schools and one of England's most famous football clubs.

The Lions' side of the bargain:

- We will provide a designated member of the first team squad to be adopted by the school. The player will make regular visits, participating in school and other activities and acting as a role model for young people.
- We will provide ticket opportunities for young people to attend selected first team and reserve matches - school and football club partners will be provided with subsidised or free tickets for designated matches.
- We will provide Junior Lions membership packs free to all participants. Membership provides many benefits including open days, training evenings and material benefits including discounts from national attractions and local businesses.

The school's side of the bargain:

To participate fully each school will...

- Encourage participation of the adopted player in specific school activities.
- Endeavour to enrol pupils into the Junior Lions programme.
- Be supportive of the football club and help promote its active role in the community.

To become a Junior Lions School Partner the school must purchase at least 10 Junior Lions Memberships - £10 each
