Waiting for a student dyslexia assessment?

Organise for a member of staff to attend an accredited dyslexia course to carry out in school screeners.

Contact the SEND hub to find out if there are any assessors in neighbouring schools and how much they charge.

FOCUS ON SEND STANDARDS

Standard 1 - An inclusive setting: providing a positive and supportive environment for all

S1 Point 1 - Ensure all pupils have access to high quality teaching.

While being organised is important for all teachers, SENCOs have the added pressure of working to statutory deadlines, which can sometimes lead to losing track of what is happening in the classroom.

What can you do?

- Carry out classroom observations
- Communicate regularly with teaching and support staff
- Organise joint PPA time for teachers and support staff to ensure a collaborative approach to working with children and young people with SEND.
